Takahe & Tui Information Sheet

Our theme for Ag Day this year is...



Tamariki have been very busy in class making all sorts of **SPACE** art that we are looking forward to sharing with you on Ag Day - Saturday 23rd September.

Each child will create 8 indoor exhibits. These will be displayed in each child's classroom and will be judged by independent people prior to Ag Day. The exhibits will be available for viewing on Ag Day when classrooms open at 11:00am on the day.

To help us complete our indoor exhibits one of the baking items is required to be made at home, and some of the floral exhibits that is made at school will use resources that are sourced and brought from home. Details about what these exhibits require are on the next page. Please send any items from home in a clearly named bag or container by the indicated due dates.

Visual Art Exhibits: All three of these pieces will be created at school.

Baking Exhibits: One piece of baking will be made at school prior to Ag Day. The other will need to be made and assembled at home, then brought to school on Friday 22nd September.

Floral Exhibits: All three floral exhibits will be made at school with some items required to be bought from home for two of them.

Bouquet in Space Jar



Students will decorate the jar in class starting in Week 7, prior to Ag day.

Please bring a 500g glass jar to school by Week 6, for students to decorate before Ag day.

Please bring long stemmed flowers to fit the 500g glass jar to school on Friday 22 September with the other floral pieces.

Sand saucer



Students will create a sand saucer using flowers and greenery to decorate.

Their objective is to cover the sand with the flowers and greenery by making a symmetrical pattern.

Paper bowls and sand will be provided.

You will need to bring the following items on Friday 22 September:

- A selection of flowers and greenery

Galaxy cupcake



This must be created at home and brought in already assembled on Friday 22 September.

You can either make a cupcake or buy a pre-made cupcake (students only need to bring one in).

You can decorate it using any lollies/ icing sugar/ fondant/ cake decorations you like to create a galaxy themed cupcake.

Be as creative as you like with your galaxy themed decorations!
