



Agricultural Day Indoor Exhibits notice for Piwakawaka students:

On Friday 28 September, the day before Ag Day, Piwakawaka students will be preparing 4 exhibits.

On Saturday 30 September, you and your whanau will be invited to come and see what your child has made in class.

Please support your child by having the following items ready for your child to bring to school on the **Friday 28 September:**

Vaseline Saucer: Students will need an ice cream container lid and suitable petals to create a pattern. (Vaseline will be provided at school).

Miniature Garden: Students will need a small-medium sized tin foil, roasting tray, (\$2 shop, supermarket). Suitable, natural objects to create a garden eg: a dinosaur land, a fairy garden, a spooky forest, a farm, a cottage garden etc... Natural objects include; pebbles, shells, flowers, small sticks, moss, leaves, drift wood, sand, grass, hay, twigs etc... a few little “toys” or “figures” is ok, but a maximum of 3. (We will use sand from school to fill the tray, the garden, decorations go on top). NO DIRT.

Decorated Biscuit: All materials provided on the day.

A Wild Flower Arrangement: Please bring a small-medium sized bunch of wild flowers to put into a special container that has been made in class.

However, they will be expected to create their items independently on the day. Students are welcome to practice any of the above activities beforehand at home.
