Indoor Exhibits: You are asked to complete 8 exhibits.

All cooking is to be done at home and brought to school on **Friday 28th September**.
All flowers, containers etc need to be brought to school and completed at school on Friday.

Art:

You will complete three pieces of work at school. **You must enter 3 pieces.**

- **Weaving**
- **Sewing**
- **Papier Mache**
- **Drawing**

Floral Exhibits: Choose 3 of the following:

- An unusual container, with flowers
- Aqua Jar (one flower, no bubbles)
- Floral arrangement with space theme
- Petal Alien on ice-cream lid (flower petals stuck with Vaseline onto lid)



Baking: Choose 2 of the following:

- 2 plain scones (one to be cut open to display the texture)
 - 1 plaited (woven) mini bread loaf on a plate (length – no more than 20cm)
 - 3 decorated cupcakes on a small plate (Space theme)
- (Any baking should be covered with plastic film).

Animal: If you choose to raise and show an animal, it will be one of the following:
Calf rearing Lamb rearing Goat rearing Chicken rearing

Project Topic: “Recycled Robot”

You have the term to complete this project. Sheet overleaf. This is compulsory for everyone, **except** pupils who have an animal /chicken for agricultural day.

Garden Competition - This is separate to Agricultural day.

You may choose to plant and raise a vegetable or flower garden. The gardens will be judged separately in November and prizes awarded at the end of the year.

(Ag. Day Project for Yrs. 5-8 who are “NOT” having an animal.)

“Recycled Robots”

Overview:

Make a 3D garden ornament that resembles a “robot”. Design and build a 3D model it and make a design brief drawn on paper to accompany your model.

Criteria:

- Be child-created
- Make use of recycled materials
- No bigger than your school desk (60cm L x 60cm W)
- Be reasonably weather proof
- Decorated with detail and durable for a child to play with
- A written brief in the form of a procedure (**how was it made**) and list the materials used.
