Knowing other peers are dealing with the same or similar issues can also help decrease the feeling of being alone. The Seasons Programme will run for 8 weeks during the school term, for 1 hour weekly sessions. If you would like to know more, the facilitators are happy to contact you or meet with you to discuss the programme.
