#### **HEADLICE (NITS)**

We have been advised by a few families that headlice are back in our school. Headlice are tiny black or brown insects that live in the scalp. They lay their eggs (nits) close to the scalp, attaching them with a glue like substance. Headlice travel from head to head when heads are touching.

Please check your children's hair carefully. Your local chemist can offer advice on treatment If your child does have headlice please ensure that every family member is treated. Follow up treatments are required to kill any newly hatched headlice. A Public Health pamphlet is available from the stand in the school office if you would like more information.
