- ◆ **Health Warning:** We have had a confirmed case of Cryptosporidium in one of our children. The child has now been cleared and has returned to school. It is important that if your child is unwell and has diarrhoea and stomach pains they are kept at home, have a visit to the doctor and remain away from school until they have been cleared. Incubation period can be between 1 & 12 days (usually 7 days) after becoming infected. Please remind children of thorough washing of hands after using the toilet, before eating and after playing with animals. Animals can also pass on this disease as can humans to animals. Teachers will also be stressing personal hygiene and the use of hand sanitizer in classrooms.
