- Out of Zone Enrolments—The Board of Trustees invites applications from parents who wish to enrol their children at Buckland School in 2021. Enrolment at Buckland School is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office. Application forms for out of zone places (available from the office and school website) must be received by Wednesday 23 **September 2020.** The Board of Trustees has determined we have a limited number of spaces. Priority will be given to Year 7 & 8 students. If the number of out of zone applications exceeds the number of places available students will be selected by ballot. This will take place on 24 September 2020.
- **◆ LATEST UPDATE COVID-19**
 - Teachers are doing their best to abide by the school Health and Safety rules and the government guidelines however some parents are making things very difficult and putting them in uncomfortable situations, by walking into the school grounds and visiting classrooms. Until there is a change of Alert Levels and you are informed, please do not come into the grounds. This is for the safety of **all** including your child/children.
 - •Thank you to parents who are keeping children away from school if they are sick.
 - Thank you to those parents who are getting children to school after 8.30 a.m. and picking them up at the designated time.
 - Thanks to parents who are ensuring children have a drink bottle each day and a named hand towel.
 - We continue to remind children of good hand hygiene and cough and sneeze etiquette
 - Our QR code posters are displayed around the school and we are keeping a visitor register for anyone who cannot use the app and for other invited visitors who come onsite.

◆ Animal Competition up-date—

Saturday 26th September under strict conditions. A detailed Health and Safety plan has been formulated under the Alert level 2.5 guidelines meaning that only 10 adults outside of school staff will be permitted on the grounds at any one time. Only one parent per competitor will be able to support the child and the groups will be staggered over the day. Strict guidelines regarding entry and exit times, behaviours etc have been written. Closer to the time competitors and families involved will be notified of the guidelines. No other children or adults will be able to be admitted onto the school grounds. (Should restrictions be changed the plan will be modified.)

- ◆ Fun Day for children—We are planning to continue with this (although our initial plans have had to be changed due to the Alert Level 2.5 guidelines) As above only 10 adults outside of school staff will be able to be on the grounds. Details are yet to be confirmed and will be communicated next Monday.
- Mini Cross Country—Many of our children have been training hard for this event so we have decided to have a mini cross country around the school grounds this coming Wednesday. Unfortunately parents will be unable to attend but we will endeavour to take lots of photos. Please ensure your children have suitable clothes to run in and a full drink bottle.
- ♦ Group Day for Animals—the following message was received from the Group on Friday: "It is with regret that we are cancelling Franklin Group day this year. With Auckland at Covid Level 2.5 it is more than likely we will still be there or at level 2 by the time the day arrives. Franklin Group Day cannot be run under this level and with the volunteer base relatively thin for setting up the day it will be too much to organise only to have it not eventuate. We are sorry to make this decision but feel it is necessary and our only option."
