- Mini Cross Country—Your children did very well during our mini cross country and we were proud of the efforts of those who took part. - ٨ Out of Zone Enrolments—The Board of Trustees invites applications from parents who wish to enrol their children at Buckland School in 2021. Enrolment at Buckland School is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office. Application forms for out of zone places (available from the office and school website) must be received by Wednesday 23 September 2020. The Board of Trustees has determined we have a limited number of spaces. Priority will be given to Year 7 & 8 students. If the number of out of zone applications exceeds the number of places available students will be selected by ballot. This will take place on 24 September 2020.
- Prior notice—As part of the Teachers Collective, teachers have been entitled to three teacher only days this year but because of COVID-19 we decided not to take all of these but completed courses through the holiday periods. As a day of full school professional development has landed on Friday 23 October which coincides with Labour weekend, the Board have approved this day as a teacher only day. Parents who are unable to make alternative arrangements for children will be asked to notify Mrs Glasgow during the first week of term if you will require supervision for your children on this day.
