- **Teacher Only Day—Friday 23 October**—As part of the Teachers Collective, teachers have been entitled to three teacher only days this year but because of COVID-19 we decided not to take all of these but completed courses through the holiday periods. As a day of full school professional development has landed on Friday 23 October which coincides with Labour weekend, the Board have approved this day as a teacher only day. Parents who are unable to make alternative arrangements for children and will require supervision for your children on this day must notify Mrs Glasgow by the end of this first week of term so relievers can be arranged. - Safety Reminders—All crossing of George Crescent must be done at the patrolled crossing. (Parents you need to be good role models for this!) Parents have the responsibility of ensuring the safety of children in the morning. If you are riding your bike to school you should be at least 10 years old (recommendation from NZ Police, Bike Wise and LTNZ) and must wear an approved helmet. You should be riding your bike on the road not the footpath. Any younger children must be supervised by a parent.
- SCHOOL BEGINS AT 8.50a.m. at the ringing of the hand bell. Parents are asked to say their final farewells at this time and depart from rooms so that teaching can begin promptly at
