Dear Parents and Community Members Tena Koutou

 My thoughts go out to you all at this difficult and worrying time. Special thoughts to those who are isolating, and being tested since the discovery of a local case. Keep strong, do what is asked of us and think of others. Together we will get through this. I have awaited the Government announcement today before sending out this newsletter. Auckland remains in Alert Level 4 until at least Tuesday 31 August. Parliament will meet again on Monday 30 August to make a further decision therefore ... Our school site is closed. There is no access to school sites during Alert Level 4. Playgrounds (including public playgrounds) are also closed to reduce the risk of the virus spreading.

A big thank you for taking the lockdown seriously and doing what we have been asked – we've seen before that staying at home will break the chain of transmission and save lives. It is even more important that we all follow the health advice because the Delta variant is very contagious.

Breaking the rules risks the health of those close to you, the wider community and could result in the lock down period being extended.

As always, please let us know if there is anything you need to support you and your tamariki during this time.

If you are concerned that someone is not following the rules, you can report it to <u>the COVID-19 Compliance Cen-</u> <u>tre</u>. This includes people not complying with:

- Alert Level restrictions
- managed isolation requirements

Out of Zone Enrolments

The Board of Trustees invites applications from parents who wish to enrol their children at Buckland School in 2022. Enrolment at Buckland School is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office. Application forms for out of zone places (available from the office and school website) must be received by **Wednesday 22 September 2021.**

The Board of Trustees has determined we have a limited number of spaces. If the number of out of zone applications exceeds the number of places available students will be selected by ballot. This will take place on 24 September 2021.
