- ◆ Ag Day Trophies—please return all trophies won on Agricultural Day so we can get them engraved.
- Calendars, Cards, Diaries, Mouse Mats & Sketch Pads—last week every child was given an order form for calendars etc. Orders need to be returned by Thursday 3 November no late orders will be accepted. Payment can be made by cash or into the school's bank account. Completed forms should be placed in the drawer in the office foyer.
- Hats—these are to be worn this term. There are supplies available from the uniform shop that is open on Tuesday mornings from 8.30a.m. Thanks to Mrs Collins for running this for us. Please name all items of clothing so they can be handed back if lost.
- ◆ Covid Update— We are continuing to remind children of the need for good hygiene and sneezing procedures and are ensuring that we ventilate classrooms by opening doors and windows. Those who wish to continue wearing masks will be supported. Please ensure that sick children stay at home as there are still cases in our community and anything we can do to prevent the spread of illnesses as a school community will benefit all our students, staff and whanau.

- ◆ Safety Reminders—All crossing of George Crescent must be done at the patrolled crossing. (Parents you need to be good role models for this!) Parents have the responsibility of ensuring the safety of children crossing the main road. If children are riding their bike to school they should be at least 10 years old (recommendation from NZ Police, Bike Wise and LTNZ) and must wear an approved helmet. They should be riding the bike on the road not the footpath. Any younger children must be supervised by a parent.
- Dates for the Term—These are on the back, please put them in a safe place. They are also available on our Website calendar.
- ◆ Dates for 2023—The Board has approved the following dates for 2023: Term 1—Wed 1 February—Thursday 6 April. Term 2—Wed 26 April—Friday 30 June. Term 3—Monday 17 July—Friday 22 September. Term 4—Monday 9 October—Friday 15 December. Please make holiday arrangements outside of these dates so attendance is not disrupted.
