- ◆ I hope you and your families are all safe and well after yet another weather event that has prevented us from being at school. If you have been impacted and we can be of any help or support please do not hesitate to contact us. Our closures were emailed to you, put on the front page of our school website and messaged on the Skool Loop App. If you did not receive emails please let us know so that we can check our contact lists.
- We were very pleased with the way children settled back into school routines last week. We hope this will again be the case this week and that next week we can have a full week of lessons.
- School Values: Respect,
 Responsibility and Resilience. We
 hope you all will support staff and
 children with encouraging and
 modelling these values.
- Our first **House Meetings** were held last Thursday. We have four Houses: Rimu (Green) Kauri (Red) Totara (Blue), Kowhai (Yellow.) Each child is put into a House on enrolment. We put all siblings in the same House. Children work towards gaining points during the week and at sports events for their House. These go towards the fortnightly assembly shield. Points then get accumulated with a winning House chosen and awarded the House Shield at the end of the year.
- We held a Fire Drill last week and I can report children handled the drill in a responsible and sensible way.
- Dates for 2023 Terms: Please book holidays during holiday periods where ever possible as we want children's attendance to be high. Term 1: Tuesday 7 Feb—Thursday 6 April. Easter and Anzac day fall in the holidays.

Term 2: Wednesday 26 April–Friday 30 June.

Term 3: Monday 17 July–Friday 22 September (Sat 23 Sept—Ag Day) Term 4: Monday 9 October–Friday 15 Dec

There will also be 2 teacher only days through the year (as designated by the MOE for teacher professional development on the revised curriculum—one being the day before Anzac day.) A date for the second one will be advertised as soon as it is confirmed.

 Absences: Please notify the school early each morning that children are going to be away, stating the reason for the absence. An answer phone

- operates for your convenience. You can also use the Skool App or administration email: GMills@buckland.school.nz if these are easier for you. It is costly for the school both in time and resources to have to ring you to check your children are safe. Please note the Ministry guidelines: Prior permission from the principal is to be obtained before a holiday during term time. Children will be marked as absent. Where-ever possible however please make trips out of school time so that your child's progress is not interrupted—EVERY DAY COUNTS.
- Reminder Notices—Please refer to last week's newsletter for reminders on: cell phones, Hats, Uniform expectations, Water only, Lollies & Birthday cake.
- Dates for the Term—as the Franklin Sports meeting is yet to be held and therefore dates not yet confirmed, these will be in next week's newsletter and placed on the website and Skool Loop App calendar.
- School Times: Thank you to parents who are getting children to school on time and ready for the 8.50a.m. handbell. School begins at 8.55a.m. This allows for our Year 0—2 students to be picked up at 2.55p.m. All other students are released at 3 p.m. To reduce congestion at the front gate please take your child/children and leave straight away to allow other parents to park. A réminder NO parking over our neighbours' driveways and PLEASE use the patrolled crossing. Thanks to our Senior students who are doing a crossing duty.
- ◆ Interval is 10.10—10.30 with lunch break 12.00—12.45. The first 15 minutes of lunch are assigned to sitting down and eating. Teachers will be on duty to check that children eat their lunch. If however, you notice your child is bringing home their lunch please let us know. A short brain break will be held at 1.45p.m.
- Swimming Lessons—As we needed to leave the pool covers off during the weather event it will take several days for the pool to reach temperature. This week, put togs etc into bags but teachers will not take children if it is too cold. Hopefully we will be back to daily swimming lessons with teachers next week. The wearing of rash shirts is compulsory while in the pool. Please name these as well as goggles, towels and togs. If you have any old ones that don't fit your child/children any longer we would appreciate them.

- Lunchtime swims—Will be available once the pool heats up. Classes have been rostered on each day and those classes will have priority. If there is sufficient safe numbers, other children will be invited in by the duty teacher.
- Breakfast Club— Our Breakfast Club is up and running on Tuesdays and Fridays on the back library deck. If any parents would like to help with this or provide fruit your assistance will be appreciated.
- Weekly Newsletters— A weekly newsletter (that comes out on the first school day of each week) will be placed on our website, emailed to those who have given us email addresses and also placed on our Skool Loop App. If you do however require a paper copy please contact the office and one will be arranged for you. We will place a copy of this on the school noticeboard in front of the office each week as well. If we don't have your email address and you want the newsletter emailed please provide it.
