- Attendance Issue 3— Each week I will be putting in a snippet from the Ministry of Education slide show on attendance.

Attendance—What is expected of parents

You must enrol your child at school, and you must ensure they attend every day the school is open (ie term time). These are legal requirements from the Education and Training Act 2020.

Contact us if your child is going to be absent (ie if your child will not be at school for a whole day, or part of a day, or if they are going to be late).

Talk with your child about why attending school every day is important for their learning and their future.

If your child is reluctant to come to school, talk with them. If something is happening at school that is making them want to miss school, talk with us so we can work together.

Getting back to school quickly after being absent is important. Support your child return to school as

soon as possible. The longer your child is absent from school, the harder it can be to catch up on

missed learning. Again, talk with us so we can work together.
