<p><b>Miniature Natural Scene</b></p> 	<p>We will make the miniature scenes at school. We will provide the container (26cm by 14cm ) and sand. All you will need to do is supply the <b>scene materials</b>. Please use natural materials only e.g. moss, greenery, stones.</p> <p>You may make things, for example fences from sticks using glue guns at home if you wish.</p> <p>Please bring the materials in on <b><u>Friday 19th September</u></b>. We are going to assemble the miniature gardens on this day.</p> <p>(Use jelly / coloured rice for water)</p>
<p><b><u>Unusual Container of Weeds:</u></b></p> 	<p>Please bring an Unusual Container that <u>holds water</u>. As there is a shortage of flowers and they are very expensive we have decided to fill the container with a weed or succulent arrangement.</p> <p>Please bring your container and weeds/ succulents in on <b><u>Friday 19th September</u></b>. We will assemble the arrangement at school on this day.</p>
