Ministry of Education School Donation Scheme

The Board has opted into the School Donation Scheme again this year which means that we will not be collecting school donations or fees.

So far we have covered the cost of Mathletics, Writer's Toolbox, Reading Eggs, Technology (Year 7 & 8) and Yr 1 & 2 EOTC costs (buses, entry fees and whanau dinner for our students). We will continue to use the scheme throughout the year to fund further activities for all age groups.

TERM 1 ACTIVITIES REVIEW

The year got off to a flying start with the swimming sports and swimming demonstrations. It was great to see the students cheering and supporting each other and the large parent turnout. Children who qualified at our swimming sports went on to compete



at the North Group events and the Franklin swimming events. This year we sent three Year 7 & 8 students to the Auckland Championship Swimming in Auckland. Thanks to Mrs Robertson for providing extra coaching for our swimmers before school.

Also as part of our swimming programme Fulton Swimming School have provided "Swim For Life" swimming lessons for all students over a three week period during February and March.

The Year 1 & 2 children held their EOTC week in the middle of March with a trip to the Botanical Gardens in Manurewa and the wave pools at Mt Albert Aquatic Centre. Many thanks to all the parents who offered

their help with the trips, in school activities and the whanau dinner. These events don't happen without a lot of parental support.

Our Kapa Haka Group performed at the Franklin Multicultural Festival. We thank Mrs King and Mrs Bartlett for organising and training the students. 30 students attended Eye on Nature and our Year 5 & 6 children attended Spongy Schools both at the Botanic Gardens in Manurewa. Thanks to Mrs King and Mrs Miles for organising these trips.

Mrs King and Mrs Glasgow took eight students to Wesley College to receive

coaching in performing a new local Haka. These students are now teaching our Kapa Haka group this new Haka.

We have finished this term with our Year 5-8 students competing at the Franklin Rippa Rugby tournaments.
