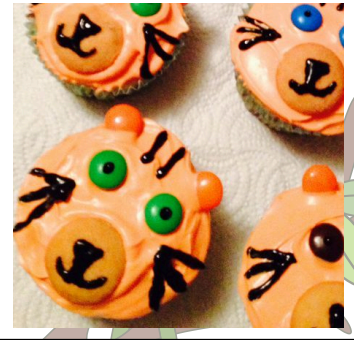

# Jungle Miniature Garden Scene



Students will make a Jungle Miniature Scene - please note this garden must be created at school on Friday 25 September so please do not send the garden preassembled, children can however make items to go in their Jungle Garden at home.  
It is a good idea for children to also come up with a design/plan at home - a picture or photo of this can be brought to school to help when creating their design.

They will need:

- A tray of choice for presenting the Jungle Miniature Garden (any shape, no bigger than 30x30cm please).
- A selection of plant-life to put in your Garden. These could be weeds, flowers, herbs, greenery and/or succulents - real or fake. We encourage you to forage instead of buy where possible!
- A selection of unique items to make your garden look like a jungle (e.g. animals made out of clay, river, waterfall, trees, vines, rocks, bushes, waterhole, etc.)

# Sand Saucer



Children will create a sand saucer using flowers and greenery to decorate.

Their objective is to cover the sand fully with the flowers and greenery by making a symmetrical pattern.

Paper bowls and sand will be provided.
