Part One:

Research and design a plan for what you think the ultimate school playground would look like and have in it. Think about equipment that you think would provide challenging learning experiences and a fun environment to play in.

You need to consider safety issues, attractive surroundings and explain why you have chosen to include the equipment, etc that you have put in your design e.g. how it will help development, look good, be fun to play on.

This information needs to be presented in an attractive and accurate way. You can choose the means of presentation e.g. chart, booklet, poster, powerpoint, brochure, mobile, etc.

Part Two:

Build a model to support your research and plan including the things you want in your ultimate school playground. This model should be no bigger than an A2 sheet of paper and can be built out of whatever recycled materials you think are suitable.
