


Agricultural Day

Use of the School Pool

Following our last Community Survey the Board initiated a review into the practicalities of extending the use of our school pool to our community outside of school hours.

A lot of research was compiled into the benefits and challenges of this, particularly in regards to the Health and Safety in Employment Act and costs of compliance for water testing.

At our August meeting a vote was cast regarding extending the use of the pool. The outcome of the vote meant the Board’s decision was to keep with the current arrangement. The school will continue to allow after-school swimming during the warmer months till 5pm, and we will look to host more community pool-side events like our “Welcome back to school BBQ” in February.
