Rules for using the pool are on the wall of the changing room. These must be adhered to, to ensure the safety of all. Please put covers on carefully and lock gate. Return the key to Mrs Glasgow after use.
 - Safety at the School gate— Children will assemble at the front of the school for pickup. Please come onto the grounds to collect your children. The patrolled crossings must be used to ensure the safety of all children. We run a Walking School • Bus thanks to our wonderful parent volunteers.
